He has mixed over four thousand live concerts, and before coming to Yoshi's, was with Anthology San Diego for seven years. In the 80's he was on the theater arts faculty at UC Santa Cruz. While working with horses as a veterinary assistant, he produced the Emmy-winning "Horse Vet." A native Californian, he has lived in Los Angeles, Carmel, Santa Cruz, Ventura, San Diego, Lake Tahoe, Oakland and Richmond. He considers Yoshi's to be one of the finest music venues in the world.
